FROM 1st APRIL to 1st SEPTEMBER**

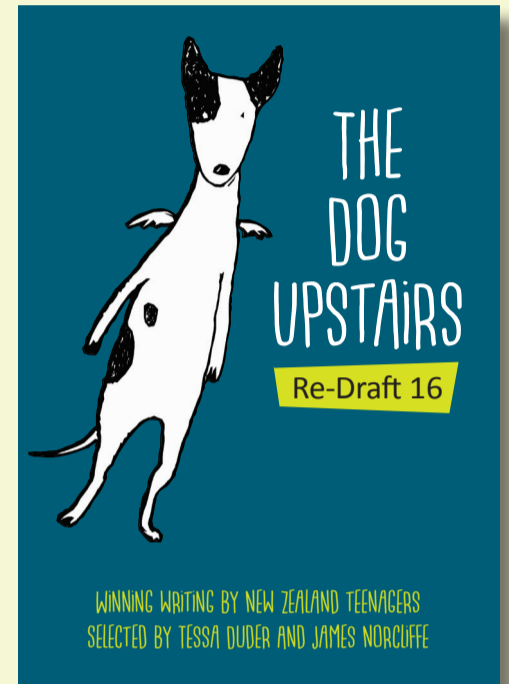
Read the guidelines carefully and make sure you respect the instructions.
